ISCA Equity Scholarship

At ISCA there is an integrated college community of international and Australian students, which embraces all cultures and benefits from breadth and diversity. It is a key value of ISCA to enable students from all backgrounds to have an opportunity to study at tertiary level. ISCA provides equity scholarships for both tuition and accommodation, to help financially disadvantaged Australian students.

A number of Equity scholarships are available of varying values. These Equity Scholarships provide tuition fee waivers to a level decided by the ICMS Scholarship Board in each case. The ICMS Scholarship Board is also able to consider Accommodation/Living Costs scholarships for the eligible applicants of various values and duration.

The ICMS Scholarship Board will manage the selection and allocation of funds. Tuition and/or accommodation/living cost funds are disbursed directly to ISCA on behalf of the recipient of the Equity Scholarship.

Value:	UP TO \$20,000*
Applications Due:	5pm Thursday 24 April 2025 (for the May 2025 study period).

How to Apply:

- 1. Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria found below
- **2.** Complete your application and prepare your report supporting your application and other documentation if required
- **3.** Apply online at www.icms.edu.au/scholarships OR mail it to ICMS Scholarships, 151 Darley Road, Manly NSW 2095 by 5pm Thursday 24 April 2025**.

* Value of Scholarships varies according to the course undertaken and may vary from the estimated value printed here, and from year to year.

Eligibility:

The eligibility requirements for the ISCA Equity Scholarship are as follows:

- 1. Australian citizens or permanent residents.
- 2. Must be a full-time student and have successfully completed Year 12 or equivalent.
- 3. Can demonstrate financial hardship A person is considered to be experiencing financial hardship when they are:
 - a) Receiving a Centrelink (or other Commonwealth) means tested income support payment or
 - Expected to receive a Centrelink (or other Commonwealth) means-tested income support payment during 2025

or

c) Able to provide comprehensive information demonstrating exceptional hardship

Evidence of financial hardship – Equity Scholarship applicants can claim financial hardship under only one of the above categories of financial hardship. Applicants claiming financial hardship must provide one of the following types of evidence. The type of evidence you must provide relates directly to the category of financial hardship you're claiming:

- a) Provision of your Centrelink Customer Reference Number (CRN) when completing the online application or
- b) No documentation is required to support eligibility if you expect to receive a means-tested payment. However, when you submit an equity scholarship application, you will be required to verify your receipt of an allowance to ISCA before the Scholarship is be taken up
 - or
- c) Documentation provided to support eligibility for exceptional financial hardship must demonstrate a level of real enduring financial hardship.
- 4. Applicants under any of the above categories must prepare a one-page report in support of their application (refer to Report for details).

Meeting the scholarship eligibility criteria doesn't guarantee that you'll be awarded a scholarship. There are a limited number of Equity Scholarships and there are more applicants than scholarships. As part of a competitive application process, applicants are ranked against the eligibility criteria and the ICMS Scholarship Board will award the Equity Scholarships to those who are judged by the committee to best meet the eligibility criteria.

If you're not successful, it doesn't mean you're not in need; rather, it means there are other applicants who've been assessed as being in greater need.

Report:

Please submit a one-page report addressing the following points:

- Why do you believe you should be awarded an Equity Scholarship?
- Why ISCA?
- Why is your chosen course the best choice for you?
- Any other information you wish to include to support your application

Selection Process:

- The application form (and any supplementary information) is designed to gather sufficient information from applicants to determine which applicants best meet the eligibility criteria and can progress to the panel interview.
- Students who meet the eligibility criteria will progress to the interview stage. The interview is conducted by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- ICMS Scholarship Board will award the ISCA Equity Scholarships after considering the information contained in the applications submitted and the completed panel interview.
- The decision of the ICMS Scholarship Board is final.

Offer Material:

If your application for an Equity Scholarship is successful, you'll receive a scholarship offer with your letter of offer for a place in your course.

Your offer material will include details about the scholarship you've been awarded and the terms and conditions for accepting the offer.

When you accept an Equity Scholarship offer, you must agree to provide any personal information requested by ICMS Scholarship Board to assess your ongoing eligibility for the Scholarship.

Your Equity Scholarship offer is made on the condition that you remain eligible to receive the Equity Scholarship on each census date during the currency of your Scholarship.

Deferment:

Deferment of an Equity Scholarship is not permitted prior to your course or during.

Students awarded an Equity Scholarship who defer the start of their studies or who withdraw from their course, will forfeit their Equity Scholarship. Students may re-apply for a scholarship if they start studies at ISCA at a later date.

Termination of an ISCA Equity Scholarship:

If the Equity Scholarship you've been awarded is for longer than one year, it will be terminated if:

- You cease to meet the eligibility requirements for your Equity Scholarship
- The maximum duration of the Equity Scholarship has been reached (if applicable)
- You've failed to make satisfactory academic progress as defined by ISCA
- You've committed misconduct (e.g. provided false or misleading information See Student Handbook)

NOTE: Scholarship submissions will **not be returned**. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.

Terms & Conditions

- 1. The Scholarship recipient is required to sign this acceptance form and return to the ICMS Scholarship Board on or before enrolment.
- 2. International Sport College Australia (ISCA) Equity Scholarships are not refundable and non-transferrable. The scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
- 3. The recipient of the ISCA Equity Scholarship agrees to abide by all admissions criteria and all requirements prescribed by the ISCA whilst enrolled.
- 4. Applicants must have a full time or equivalent study load to be eligible to apply.
- 5. The recipient of the ISCA Equity Scholarship must commence the program in the May 2025 study period.
- 6. If the Scholarship Recipient fails a subject, he/she is obliged to retake the subject at their cost at the full subject price.
- 7. The ISCA Equity Scholarship is a tuition waiver (and/or accommodation) waiver that can only be used for the purpose of attending ISCA for the program as specified. The balance of remaining fees, including tuition, accommodation, uniforms, text books and any other program related costs for each enrolling study period must be paid in full prior to study period commencement.
- 8. In certain cases, the scholarship amount awarded will be credited to tuition as a portion of the fees in each study period for the duration of the course of their study or until the scholarship credit is exhausted. In some cases scholarship credit can and may be applied to a later study period than the commencement study period.
- 9. In the case of the scholarship recipient discontinuing studies any and all remaining credit will be forfeited.
- 10. The value of the scholarship and the timing of the credit apportionment are not negotiable and not changeable.
- 11. At no time will any scholarship credit apply to fees already paid.
- 12. Partial scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high. Subject to approval by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- 13. The Scholarship is not available to students using any other scholarship, bursary or discount at ISCA*.
- 14. The recipient acknowledges and upholds the confidentiality of receiving the ISCA Equity Scholarship
- 15. The ISCA Equity Scholarship offers a tuition wavier and/or accommodation/living costs credit.

Accommodation/Living Costs Credit description:

Rooms are equipped with a desk, wardrobe, heating and wireless internet. All linen is provided and rooms are dusted and vacuumed once a week. Each floor is equipped with a kitchenette, common showers, toilets and ironing facilities. You will also receive residential support from the residential assistants.

Your accommodation/Living Costs credit includes the following for the duration of the scholarship credit and eligibility:

- Rent
- 3 x Meals per day (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) Monday to Friday
- 2 x Meals per day (Brunch and Dinner) Weekends
- Electricity, Gas & Water
- On site parking
- Campus wide Wi-Fi
- 16. ISCA provides support and assistance, through the Student Success Center here at the college. It is expected that the student where required or needed will be proactive in seeking these services as required in order to complete their studies to the best of their ability.
- 17. The ISCA Equity Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ISCA Diploma of Sport

Management (High Performance).

- 18. ISCA Equity Scholarships may be discontinued by the College, dependent upon termly review of academic integrity, standing and student conduct.
- 19. Academic Integrity will be reviewed from time to time. Any academic misconduct can inhibit your scholarship. Academic misconduct registered as level 2 or 3 during the applicable scholarship, will result in immediate discontinuation of the scholarship.
- 20. The ISCA Equity Scholarship is not able to be deferred.
- 21. College fees are subject to change.

*Excludes the ICMS Regional and Interstate Student Accommodation Bursary.
